

ULUSABA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE - ROOM CATEGORIES

Sir Richard Branson's award winning private game reserve Ulusaba is set in Sabi Sand and traverses over 13,500 hectares of unspoilt game rich bush in big 5 territory. With two beautiful lodges set 0.5km apart and offering two different perspectives over the bush, guests can share their time between the two lodges - Rock Lodge and Safari Lodge.

Ulusaba strikes the perfect balance between nature and nurture - as well as being an excellent place to observe the 'Big Five', it is also an ideal place to kick back and unwind. Ulusaba re-defines the rules of a safari lodge by offering swimming pools, gymnasiums, a wine cellar, Aroma Boma spas with panoramic views, a Bush Observatory perfect for star gazing and tennis courts. Make sure you save time to enjoy the safari walks, moon-lit bush dinners and of course, the twice daily game drives.

Safari Lodge is built along the banks of the dry Mabrak riverbed, where guests will love the sense of adventure as they cross the swing bridges between exquisite tree house rooms, created and inspired by local and natural materials, with elephant, bushbuck, lion and other local wildlife passing by. Safari Lodge can accommodate up to 22 guests in 11 rooms and suites.



Safari Room (x3): 30 sqm

Our lead in room category at Ulusaba, we have three adjoining Safari Rooms close to the Main Lodge, offering large viewing decks and en-suite bathrooms with great views.



Elephant Room (x3): 60 sqm

Built tree house style high above the bush, we have three spacious Elephant Rooms with en-suite bathrooms and large viewing decks offering stunning views over the bush.



River Room (x4): 100 sqm

Built tree house style and very private we have four River Rooms, of which River Rooms 2 and 4 offer private infinity plunge pools. All are very spacious and offer en-suite bathrooms with views. River Rooms 2, 3 and 4 are accessible by swing bridge and are a short walk from the main Lodge.



Treehouse Suite (x1): 160 sqm

A spacious and very private suite featuring a private deck with views over Xikwenga Dam where hippos and elephants come to bathe. There is also a large viewing deck adjacent to the room perfect for breakfasts, lunches and private dinners accommodating 16 people. The Treehouse Suite is an approximate 10 minute walk from the main lodge and is accessible by swing bridges and raised walkways.

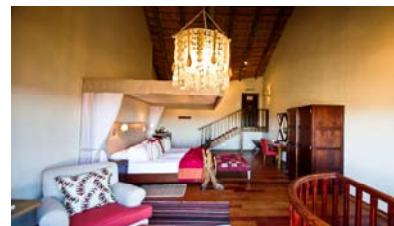
- o Gift Shop and wine cellar, guests from either lodge are welcome

Rock Lodge is perched high on the summit of a koppie and provides panoramic views across the bush and the Drakensberg Mountain range, the wildlife roaming within and the beauty of the lowveld below. Recently refurbished our 8 rooms and suites at Rock Lodge have been given a fabulous facelift. Each is unique with a contemporary African design and a hint of tribal flair. In addition to Cliff Lodge featuring two magnificent suites we can accommodate a total of 20-25 guests and welcomes children of all ages to the Ulusaba Cub's Club.



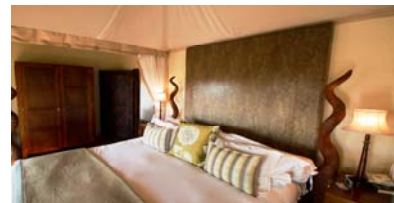
Rock Cliff Room (x4): 70 sqm

There are four adjoining Rock Cliff rooms, all south facing with views over the vast landscape. Rooms are spacious and offer en-suite bathrooms with spectacular views. Two of these rooms are built on split levels with a spiral staircase connecting the bedroom and bathroom.



Rock Suite (x1): 125 sqm

A spacious two bedroom suite with living area, the master bedroom has a full en-suite and views over the bush, and the second queen bedded room a smaller en-suite bathroom.



Master Suite (x1): 115 sqm

Built on 3 levels with beautiful views, an en-suite bathroom, and private balcony with infinity plunge pool. The living area features a telescope and iPod docking station.



Makwela Suite (x2): 125 sqm

2 lavish suites built on two levels with full en-suite bathrooms and featuring private balconies with infinity edge plunge pools. With separate living area and study/library, each has a luxurious fold-out sleeper couch suitable for children.



Cliff Lodge, located a short walk from the Main House at Rock Lodge, features two magnificent suites offering guests the ultimate in safari luxury. When you hire both suites for exclusive use your own chef and private vehicle for game drives is included. Cliff Lodge can accommodate a maximum of 5 adults and 4 children when booked exclusively. The two Cliff Lodge Suites can also be booked individually within 4 months prior to guest arrival.

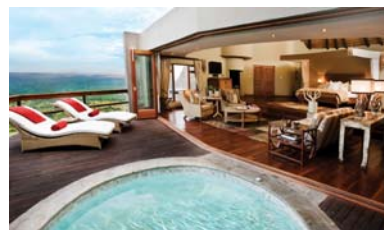
Cliff Lodge 1: 330 sqm

A luxurious two bedroom suite accommodating up to 3 adults and 2 children with one large bedroom and a second smaller bedroom. Cliff Lodge 1 offers a spacious lounge with fireplace, separate kitchen and bar and also features a small spa, gym and an outdoor deck with a large pool.



Cliff Lodge 2: 120 sqm

A spacious one bedroom suite accommodating up to 2 adults and 2 children on 2 small pull out beds. Cliff Lodge 2 offers a lounge area with fireplace and a large viewing deck with Jacuzzi. A TV in the lounge with DVD player and a selection of DVD's is provided in both Cliff Lodge Suites.

What can you expect to find in your room? King size beds (except for the second bedroom in Rock Suite and the second bedroom in Cliff Lodge Suite 1). A well-stocked complimentary mini bar with snacks, tea and coffee-making facilities, bottled water, safety deposit box, Bose or iPod station, hairdryer, spray-on insect repellent, Africology toiletries, bathrobes and slippers. All rooms have air-conditioning, ceiling fans and mosquito nets as well as en-suite bathrooms and a terrace or balcony.

When is the best time to visit? - Any time! The landscape changes with every season, so each visit will give you a different perspective on the African Bush. In summer (October to April) the temperature averages 34°C/93°F. The days are glorious, the vegetation lush and the nights pleasantly warm. During winter (May to September) the days are moderately warm and sunny with an average temperature of 26°C/79°F, while the nights are cool and crisp.

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
